

EMERGENCY SAVINGS ACCOUNT PROGRAM

Why set up an emergency savings account?

Having a stable emergency savings fund can lead to long term financial self-sufficiency - but saving can be a challenge. WORC will be there to support you in this journey!

The goal of this program is to help you get started with emergency savings.

Savings can be done in a virtual account such as Albert, Mint or Acorns. Please review your App Store on your Smart Phone. You will save a minimum of \$700 over 3 months. Savings will be matched with \$300.

The suggested schedule of savings is:

- Month 1: Deposit \$234 in self-elected savings account
- Month 2: Deposit \$233 in self-elected savings account
- Month 3: Deposit \$233 in self-elected savings account, totaling \$700.

Eligibility Requirements

- Must have earned income
- 2. Must attend free orientation session
- 3. Must be 18 years or older
- 4. Must meet income guidelines

Required Documents

- 1. Two most recent pay stubs
- 2. Emergency Savings Enrollment Paperwork (please sign & date all signature lines)
- 3. Proof first deposit in savings account
- 4. Six (6) online money management classes are required to complete the program.
- 5. 2020 Tax Return
- 6. Valid Photo ID
